- Bring flags back to the totes for bundling
 - Choose a few people to bundle flags while others gather them
- At the TOTES:
- Bundle flags in groups of 20 rubber band tightly
 - ONE rubber band at the top wrapped twice around
 - ONE rubber band at the bottom wrapped 3x's around
 - DISREGARD tote labels Fill totes with Flag bundles
 - PLEASE do not move totes onto the lawn per the cemetery
- Trucks will pick up totes & bring to the center
- When your section is finished PLEASE help us other areas:
- We may have work stations set up in the center area
 - We'll show you what to do it's easy
