# Flag Removal Day

Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> - 8:00 am

- **Everyone is welcome** – bring all of your friends - Kids can help, too!
  - **Bring shop rags**, old towels, cut up t-shirts, etc; to wipe off the flag staffs
  - **Bring a lawn chair** or camp chair, if you'd like - entirely optional
- 

*\* This is a RAIN OR SHINE event – so dress accordingly*

**Itinerary:** *(\*This is subject to change, depending on weather)*

- **8:00 am - Meet in the center Hemi-cycle for team assignments**
- **At the Cemetery Sections – Your Team will:**
  - **Pull up the flags / Wipe off the staffs**
  - **Bring flags back to the totes for bundling**
    - *Choose a few people to bundle flags while others gather them*
- **At the TOTES:**
  - **Bundle flags in groups of 20 – rubber band tightly**
    - **ONE** rubber band at the top – wrapped **twice** around
    - **ONE** rubber band at the bottom – wrapped **3x's** around
    - **DISREGARD tote labels – Fill totes with Flag bundles**
    - **PLEASE do not move totes** onto the lawn – per the cemetery
  - **Trucks will pick up totes & bring to the center**
- **When your section is finished - PLEASE help us other areas:**
- **We may have work stations set up in the center area**
  - We'll show you what to do – it's easy
