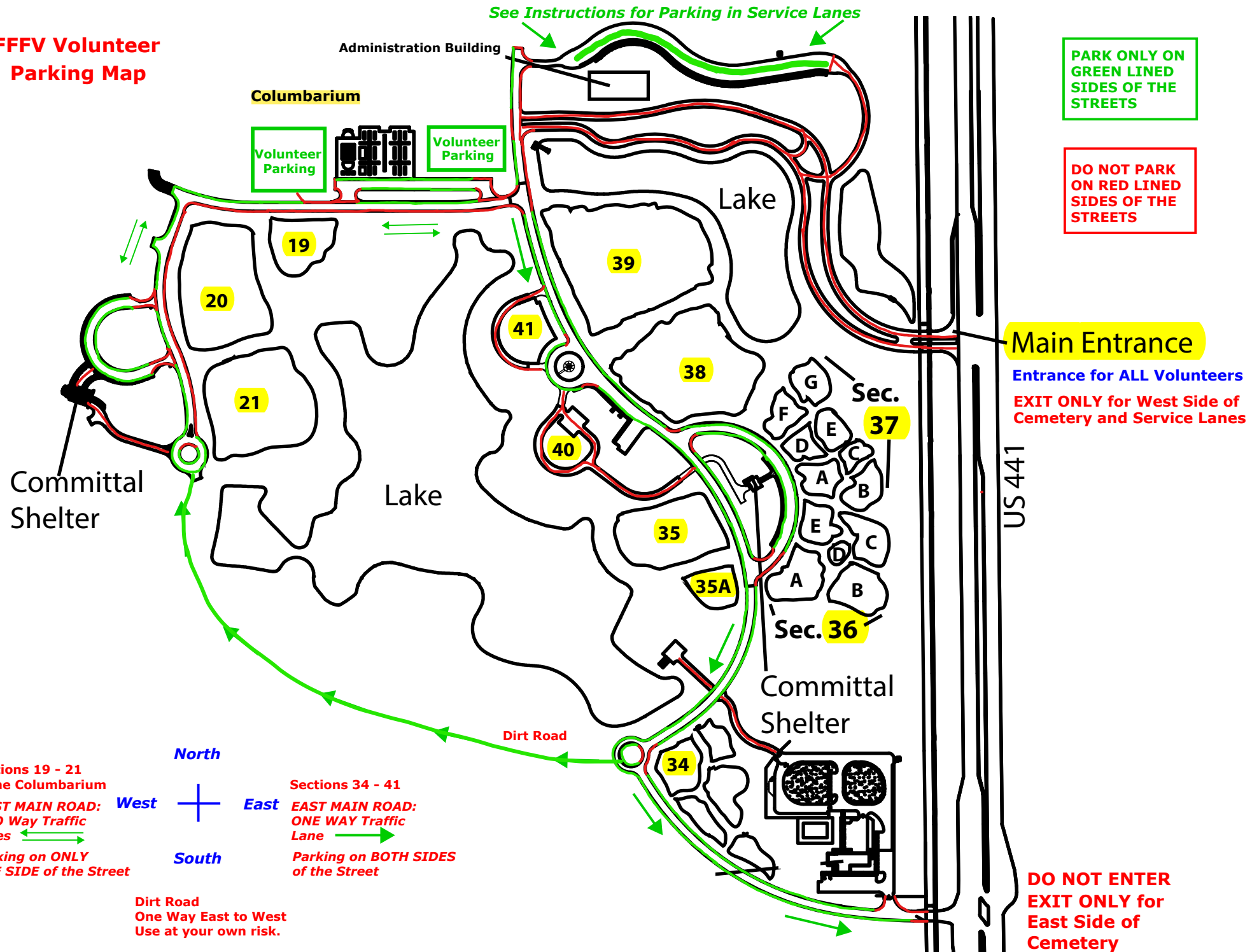


FFFV Volunteer Parking Map

VOLUNTEER PARKING

GENERAL

1. We need everybody's help to make this event a success, and it all begins as soon as you arrive at those hallowed grounds. Please drive slowly and safely and exercise driver courtesy **at all times**.
2. **PLEASE CARPOOL and PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING PARKING INSTRUCTIONS PERTAINING TO YOUR SECTION.**
3. Buses and oversized trucks or vans or any other oversized vehicles are **NOT** allowed in the Cemetery during the Event.
4. Please do not save parking spaces for other people. Nobody has any parking privileges in the Volunteer Parking Areas.
5. Park in the next available parking space. Do not keep driving around looking for a better parking space.
6. When parking, please leave enough room between your vehicle and the vehicle or motorcycle in front of you so the owner of both vehicles can safely get into their vehicle and safely leave their parking space.
7. Motorcycles are expected to safely and efficiently occupy parking spaces. Please leave enough room for the other motorcycle owner to safely mount and dismount their motorcycle.
8. The **only** authorized entrance into the Cemetery is from the Main Entrance on the **north side** of the Cemetery off State Road 7/US 441.
9. **Do not** enter the Cemetery from the Auxiliary Entrance on the **south side** of the Cemetery off State Road 7/US 441.
10. Using the attached FFFV Volunteer Parking Map, **park only on Green Lined** Sides of the Street, and **DO NOT park on RED LINED** Sides of the Street.

VOLUNTEER PARKING

PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE: Sections 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, and 41

- 1.** If you volunteer in any of the Sections 34 through 41, you are on the East Side of the Cemetery.
- 2.** The Main Road running North to South through these Sections *and* the semi-circles and roundabouts along this Main Road will all be **ONE-WAY** Roads on both Flag Placement Day and Flag Removal Day.
- 3.** You may park on **BOTH** sides of this Main Road and the semi-circles and roundabouts along the road.
- 4.** When parking, please leave enough room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you so both vehicles can safely leave their parking space.
- 5.** The end of this Main Road brings you back to State Road 7/US 441. If there is no available parking on this Main Road or the various semi-circles or roundabouts along the road, then please continue to exit the Cemetery. **DO NOT** attempt to turn around on this Main Road. Again, this Main Road is **ONE WAY** only.
- 6.** After exiting the Cemetery, you may turn north on State Road 7/US 441 to re-enter the Cemetery through the Main Entrance.
- 7.** After re-entering the Cemetery, you may try to find parking on the West Side of the Cemetery or in the Service Lanes. The Parking Instructions for the West Side of the Cemetery and the Service Lanes are provided below.
- 8.** If after re-entering the Cemetery, you still cannot find parking, you may need to find alternative parking outside the Cemetery.

VOLUNTEER PARKING

PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE: Sections 19, 20, 21 and The Columbarium

- 1.** If you volunteer in any of the Sections 19 through 21 or The Columbarium, you are on the West Side of the Cemetery.
- 2.** The Main Road running East to West then South through these Sections will be a **TWO-WAY** Road on both Flag Placement Day and Flag Removal Day. You may park on **ONLY ONE side of this Main Road.**
- 3.** The semi-circles and roundabouts along this Main Road will all be **ONE-WAY** Roads on both Flag Placement Day and Flag Removal Day. You may park on **BOTH sides of the semi-circles and roundabouts along this Main Road.**
- 4.** When parking, please leave enough room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you so both vehicles can safely leave their parking space.
- 5.** The end of this Main Road brings you to a roundabout so you can return to the Main Entrance to exit the Cemetery using this Main Road. Do not continue on to the Dirt Road to exit the Cemetery. The Dirt Road is a one-way road from the East Side of the Cemetery.
- 6.** If there is no available parking on this Main Road or the various semi-circles or roundabouts along the road, please see both the Parking Instructions for the East Side of the Cemetery and for the Service Lanes.
- 7.** If there is also no parking available on the East Side of the Cemetery or in the Service Lanes, you may need to find alternative parking outside the Cemetery.

VOLUNTEER PARKING

PARKING AT THE SERVICE LANES

- 1.** Please see the attached FFFV Volunteer Parking Map for the location of the Service Lanes on the north side of the Cemetery. The Service Lanes are the **FIRST** road on the right after entering the Cemetery from the Main Entrance.
- 2.** It is **EXTREMELY IMPORTANT** to park only in Service Lanes #1, #3, #4, and #6. **DO NOT PARK in Service Lanes #2 and #5. The Service Lanes #2 and #5 are MOVING LANES ONLY.** If you park in Service Lanes #2 and #5, you will prevent ALL the vehicles behind you from leaving the Cemetery. The Service Lane numbers are painted on the road. Service Lanes #1 and #3 will exit their Service Lanes using Lane #2, and Service Lanes #4 and #6 will exit their Service Lanes using Lane #5.
- 3.** When parking, please leave enough room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you so both vehicles can safely leave their parking space.
- 4.** Park only between the white lines painted on the road for each lane. **DO NOT PARK** before the white lines begin nor after the white lines end. If you park before the white lines begin or after the white lines end, you will prevent ALL the vehicles behind you from leaving the Cemetery.

- 6.** As you look at the Google Map Aerial View, you will see some cars are not parked between the lines causing a traffic bottleneck. Those vehicles are allowed to do that because they are not using the Service Lanes as a parking lane but rather as a moving lane. Again, please park only between the white lines painted on the road for each lane.
- 7.** IF YOU ENTER THE SERVICE LANES AREA AND THERE IS NO AVAILABLE PARKING BETWEEN THE WHITE LINES FOR SERVICE LANES #1, #3, #4, and #6, THEN IMMEDIATELY EXIT THE SERVICE LANES AREA USING THE NEAREST MOVING LANES (LANES #2 AND #5). IF THERE ARE TRAFFIC CONES IN FRONT OF LANES #2 AND #5 PREVENTING YOUR EXIT, YOU MAY SAFELY MOVE THOSE CONES TO THE SIDEWALK (SEE THE GOOGLE MAP AERIAL VIEW).

VOLUNTEER PARKING

PARKING AT THE COLUMBARIUM AND IN THE GRASS LOTS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE COLUMBARIUM

- 1.** Please see the attached FFFV Volunteer Parking Map for the location of The Columbarium Parking Lanes and the Grass Lots on both sides of The Columbarium located on the north side of the Cemetery.
- 2.** Please click on the following Google Map link to better understand the parking available at the Columbarium: [Columbarium on Google Maps](#)
- 3.** There are two Parking Lanes with 17 parking spaces each along the length of both sides of the Service Road in front of the Columbarium. The two Parking Lanes are separated by a Moving Lane. Do not park in the Moving Lane. The 17 parking spaces in each Parking Lane are separated by white lines painted on the road. Google Maps does not show these white lines.
- 4.** Do not park at the ends of the Service Road in front of the Columbarium. Parking at the ends of the Service Road will prevent access to the Grass Lots on both sides of the Columbarium.
- 5.** Park in the Grass Lots on both sides of The Columbarium at your own risk.
- 6.** Enter the Grass Lots from each end of the Service Road in front of The Columbarium.
- 7.** Do not park in the Grass Lot in a way that would block other cars from entering or leaving the Grass Lot.
- 8.** When parking, please leave enough room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of you so both vehicles can safely leave their parking space.
